

US-Ukraine deal: Trump's checkmate move that changes the balance again.



US President Donald Trump with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenses

Donald Trump has won another victory with the agreement in principle with Ukraine on rare earths, while Volodymyr Zelensky hopes that this development will lead to a better relationship with the US, given Washington's recent rapprochement with Moscow in Riyadh and Putin's upcoming meeting with the world leader.

The agreement was reached following the US decision to withdraw from claims for a \$500 billion, or \$475 billion, allowance. EUR in potential revenues from the exploitation of resources. The US president's demand had provoked strong opposition from Volodymyr Zelensky, who rejected it, and other European leaders.

The final version of the deal, dated February 24 seen by the Financial Times, envisages the creation of a fund to which Ukraine would contribute 50% of revenues from the exploitation of mineral resources, including oil, gas and related infrastructure. The fund will invest money in projects inside Ukraine.

It remains unclear what kind of security guarantees companies would require to risk working in Ukraine, even in the event of a ceasefire.

And no one knows for sure what kind of financing deals would be based on contracts between Ukraine and American companies. Also, such projects will take years to develop and require significant investment.

In practice, this means that we are at the beginning of a road that will be long, but the first step has been taken and creates new data in the effort to end the war in Ukraine after three years.

It is also a fact that Trump has managed to have channels of communication with both Moscow and Kiev, with his meetings with Putin and Zelensky expected with great interest, while Europeans are once again proving to be mere observers of developments.

Why the US Wants Ukraine's Rare Earths

Ukraine has one of Europe's largest reserves of critical minerals, including lithium and titanium, much of which is untapped.

According to the Institute of Geology, Ukraine has rare earth elements such as lanthanum and cerium, used in televisions and lighting.

Also neodymium used in wind turbines and EV batteries, but also erbium and yttrium, whose applications range from nuclear power to lasers. EU-funded research, according to<u>Independent</u>it also shows that Ukraine has reserves of scandium.

Zelensky has been trying for years to develop these resources, estimated to be worth more than 12 trillion pounds, or \$14.50 trillion. euro approximately, based on data from Forbes Ukraine.

In 2021, it offered outside investors tax breaks and investment rights to help extract these minerals. These efforts were suspended when the war began.

Minerals are vital for electric vehicles and other clean energy efforts, as well as defense production.

Foreign Policy found that Ukraine held "commercially significant deposits of 117 of the 120 most used industrial minerals in more than 8,700 deposits examined."

This includes half a million tonnes of lithium, none of which have been tapped. This makes Ukraine the largest lithium resource in Europe.

Ukraine's reserves of graphite, a key ingredient in electric vehicle batteries and nuclear reactors, account for 20% of the world's resources. The deposits are located in the center and west of the country.

The war thwarted the Ukrainian government's plans to exploit these resources, resulting in more than six trillion pounds, or 7.2 trillion pounds. Ukraine's mineral resources, which are about 53 percent of the country's total, are contained in the four regions that Putin annexed in September 2022. These are Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson, although Kherson has little value in terms of minerals.

The Crimean peninsula, annexed and occupied by Putin's forces in 2014, has about £165 billion worth of minerals, about £200 billion. euro.

German elections: Expectations in Athens for a common pace

"A decisive victory for our political family, for Germany and for Europe" was the congratulatory message of Kyriakos Mitsotakis.



Athens is closely monitoring the change in the political landscape in Germany, <u>attempting to</u> read the impact of the new scene on two levels: both Greek-German and European relations, while the "27" <u>are looking for coordination vis-à-vis Donald Trump</u> to provide answers on the future of Euro-Atlantic relations and, more broadly, are called upon to determine Europe's position in the volatile international environment. Merz and Mitsotakis "have a good channel of communication," a government source said.

Kyriakos Mitsotakis returned from the short, for personal reasons trip to the US and the morning coffee in Maximos will discuss the outcome of the early German elections as a crucial factor for the balances within Europe and the possibility of reactivating (or not) the Franco-German axis.

"The next day of the strongest European economy concerns the whole European construction and its stability," says a diplomatic source, speaking of a time of "difficult balancing acts" with a redefinition of international relations.

Christian Democrat leader Friedrich Merz belongs to the same European political family as Mitsotakis. "They have a good channel of communication," a government source said, with what this implies for the – probably – warmer relationship compared to that of the Greek prime minister and Olaf Scholz.

"You are the true center-right force in Germany, always ready to defend our common European values against populists and demagogues who threaten democracy and our way of life," the prime minister said in a message of support for the CDU, before German polls opened and the momentum of the far-right (AfD) was confirmed.

"We certainly raised issues related to the Ukrainian crisis, however, the issue was not discussed in substance... We only agreed that we would approach it." With this statement, Russian President <u>Vladimir Putin</u> foretells that an agreement to end the <u>conflict in Ukraine</u> is probably still far away, since it has not been touched yet.

"In order to resolve complex and rather tense issues, such as those related to Ukraine, both Russia and the United States must take the first step," Putin said. "This first step should be dedicated to developing a degree of trust between the two states," he added.

Russia therefore wants talks, even with the Europeans, but is not under pressure to rush through a deal it doesn't like. "We will cease hostilities only when negotiations result in a stable and sustainable outcome<u>that will suit the Russian Federation</u>", as the Russian foreign minister put it on Monday<u>Sergey Lavroy</u>.

Moscow's terms are well known: official recognition that the four regions it annexed in September 2022, along with Crimea, are now part of Russia, and withdrawal of the remaining Ukrainian troops from these areas. He also wants Kiev to commit to permanent neutrality, i.e. not to join NATO, limits its armed forces, to have a new government and to recognize and establish the rights of the Russian language in Ukraine.

The next rounds of high-level talks and contacts will be dedicated to building this trust, he continued, adding that once the talks "catch" the issue of resolving the conflict, the presence of European partners will make sense.

Putin's comments, suggesting he is in no hurry to shut down the conflict in Ukraine, came on the same day that the US president<u>Donald Trump</u>met the French president<u>Emmanuel Macron</u>on the third anniversary of the invasion, saying he was optimistic that the war in Ukraine was coming to an end.

Macron also appeared optimistic in an interview, estimating that it is "possible" to talk about a ceasefire and start negotiations for a sustainable peace within a few weeks. These conditions are considered unacceptable to Kiev. But while there is no good prospect on the war front for Ukraine, it is thought that he has not yet despaired enough to accept such a deal.

The only way to force Kiev, according to The Conversation, is either through a complete military collapse of Ukraine's forces, which does not seem likely at the moment, or by coming under intense and coordinated pressure from the West to accept Russia's terms – something we haven't seen so far since there is not even an agreement on the issue.

<u>Crete</u>

The 17-year-old who shot and wounded two people in the early hours of Sunday outside a nightclub in Heraklion, Crete, has surrendered.

According to information, the minor appeared before the investigating judge, accompanied by his lawyer, <u>three 24 hours after the bloody incident</u> and shortly before an arrest warrant was issued against him. According to <u>Creta24</u>, the 17-year-old from Fodele in the Municipality of Malevizi has been prosecuted for attempted murder in a calm mental state in a serial manner.

Five other people are charged in the case, namely the parents of the minor, his cousin and a 21-year-old friend, who was arrested yesterday, who are charged on a case-by-case basis with direct complicity in attempted murder, harboring a criminal and illegal carrying of weapons.

According to police sources, the juvenile perpetrator who shot and wounded the two young men, 21 and 27 years old, originally from Anogia, received the gun from a 19-year-old! As Creta24 reported, the "hot" and bloody episode seems to have started when one of the two young injured, namely the 27-year-old, allegedly spoke to the 17-year-old's sister.

Then the fight began, initially inside the well-known nightclub and then outside it, when it took on greater dimensions. The juvenile shot at least three times at the two youths, namely twice the 27-year-old, whom he wounded in the thighs, and once the 21-year-old, wounding him in the hip.

That he does not run one and that he is innocent, but admitting his guilt. It will certainly be interesting what Mr. Stasinopoulos will answer to the question of the Decentralized State Administration, which now invites him to explain whether he received money for his travels from both a Municipality and a PEDIN. Just to tell him that no matter how many fairy tales he comes up with, he can't fool everyone forever, because there's more to come..."

<u>Olympiacos – AEK 6-0</u>

Olympiacos threw a "party" at Karaiskakis and leveled AEK 6-0 and essentially went through to the Cup final today - Orta and Yaremchuk scored two goals each, Palma and El Kaabi scored one.

Unforgettable appearance by **Olympiacos**, inconceivable party at "G. Karaiskakis" and... beaten AEK (6-0) in the first game of the two teams for the semifinals of the Greek Cup. The Reds were overwhelming, leveled the Union and essentially went through to the grand final from today, since the rematch of Nea Filadelfia (2/4) is now of a procedural nature.

Impressive was Orta, who scored the first two goals of Olympiacos (9', 19') and had the assist to Yaremchuk for the 3-0 (22'). The Ukrainian, who also scored two goals, made it 5-0 in the 54th minute, was also excellent, while he also had the assist on Orta's second goal. Palma (47') and El Kaabi (78') scored one goal each, with the Honduran midfielder scoring his first goal for Olympiacos, while the Moroccan came on as a substitute and put the... icing on the cake. The "party" of Olympiacos was spoiled by the injuries of Orta and El Kaabi, with both players leaving the pitch of the Faliro stadium with problems and will undergo the necessary tests in the next few hours.

Tragic performance by AEK, which was leveled at "G. Karaiskakis", with the two teams facing each other again on Sunday (2/3) in Nea Filadelfia for the championship.

Red-and-white... party and 6-0!

Olympiacos entered the game strongly and scored three goals in the first 25 minutes of the match. The star for the Reds was Andre Orta, who scored in the 9th and 19th minutes for the 2-0, while in the 22nd minute he made the assist to Yaremchuk for the 3-0.

In the 9th minute, Luis Palma impressively evaded Vida, made the run from the left, entered the area, turned to Orta, the Portuguese midfielder shot, the ball went against Mukundi's feet and ended up in Stracosa's net for 1-0.

Ten minutes later Andre Orta scored for the second time in tonight's game. Roman Yaremchuk stole after Mukundi's mistake, gave the Portuguese and he as in... training sent the ball into Stracosa's net for Olympiacos' 2-0 lead.

In the 22nd minute, the roles were reversed, with the Portuguese making the pass and the Ukrainian "executing" Strakossa for 3-0. Orta evaded his opponents and turned from the left to Yaremchuk, with the experienced striker scoring from the small area.

In addition to the goals, Olympiacos had three more chances. In the 18th minute, Roman Yaremchuk shot hard from the right, but the ball went out. In the 37th minute, Andre Orta tried his foot from distance, but the ball went over the crossbar of Strakosa's goal, as did Yaremchuk's one-time shot in 45+3'. Olympiacos continued with their foot in the... In the second half, Jose Luis Medilibar's players scored twice in the first quarter: in the 47th minute with Palma and in the 54th minute with Yaremchuk.

In the 47th minute, Rodinei gave Palma a pass and he sent the ball with an impressive free-kick. Stracosa's net made it 4-0.

Seven minutes later, Yaremchuk stole the ball, "won" the battle with Vida and with a powerful shot beat the AEK goalkeeper for 5-0, with the Ukrainian center forward scoring for the second time in tonight's game.

In the 60th minute, Almeida made four changes, with Gacinovic, Cilulis, Fernandez and Mandalo replacing Szymanski, Pineda, Pierrot and Pereira. In the 67th minute, Jose Luis Medilibar made his first change of the game, which was forced, with Zelson Martins replacing Andre Orta, who felt discomfort. In the 73rd minute, the Basque made three more changes, with Stamenic, El Kaabi and Velde replacing García, Jaremchuk and Palma.

AEK, on the other hand, threatened in the 26th minute with Lamela, but Paschalakis blocked the Argentine's shot, while in the 30th minute he scored with Eliasson, but the goal was cancelled for offside by Pierrot. The Union was inferior to the circumstances, with Olympiacos dominating the pitch and dismantling Matthias Almeida's team.

Five minutes later (78'), the Reds scored a sixth goal, through El Kaabi! Zelson Martins made the turn from the left and the Moroccan striker from close range raised the score to 6-0 and made "G. Karaiskakis" ... raving!

A few minutes later, however, the Moroccan was injured and left the pitch in the 87th minute, with Olympiacos finishing the game with 10 players, after Jose Luis Medilibar had completed his changes.

AEK's team was booked in the hotel by Almeida's decision.

The 6-0 defeat by the "red-and-whites" is a "black" page in AEK's history, which is called upon to raise its head.

By decision of Matthias Almeida, the expedition did not return to Spata, but returned to the hotel where it is staying in recent years. The Cup title was lost, but the "yellow and black" are obliged to claim the best they can in Super League.

Same layout by Milan Rastavac for OFI. Under the rafters Christogeorgios, with González, Lambropoulos, Silva and Hadjitheodoridis in the back four. Bakic with Karahalios on the axis, Androutsos in front of them, while Nous, Fountas flanked Salcedo in attack.

The race

The atmosphere was amazing in the stadium from the fans of both teams. On the pitch, OFI had entered the game better and circulated the ball nicely, with Asteras taking measures on the field after the first five minutes. In the 13th minute, Fountas made the turn, with Papadopoulos catching up and blocking. In the 18th minute, Bartolo dribbled nicely, then shot from an advantageous position, but the ball went out.

OFI in the 24th minute was the one who celebrated first, when after a foul by González, Silva made the parallel turn, Papadopoulos sent off temporarily but **Fountas** got the rebound to open the score (1-0). Chaos in the stadium, as was natural with the scorer of the visitors climbing to the stand where the friends of the Cretans are.

The hosts then had a good five minutes that they had camped in the frames of the Cretans, but every moment he tried to create went unused, with the biggest being that of Hadjigiovanis from the small area.

In the half-time delays, OFI complained about a **penalty**, when after Salcedo's shot the ball found the hand of Triantafyllopoulos, with Fotia after an on-the-spot video check, showing the infringement. **Papadopoulos repelled Fountas' shot**, Nus scored on the reset but the goal was cancelled because the scorer entered the area earlier.

Somehow, Rastavac's team went to the dressing room with a one-goal lead, missing a great chance and Pantelidis' one escaped the worst (0-1).

The start of the second half was balanced, with Asteras having a double chance to equalize in the 55th minute. Initially, Bartolo shot, Christogeorgios did not clear well, Mumo got the rebound, but the ball went a little out.

In the 71st minute it was OFI's moment to threaten, when Lambropoulos took the shot, Alho sent it away, Salcedo got the rebound, but the ball went into a corner.

Asteras towards the finale of the match was trying to raise his pressure, but without substance. There was no clear mind, Pantelidis' changes did not come to him, while on the other hand Rastavac had targeted moves, which locked first of all the zero in defense and overall the qualification lead.

His last chance

The match came in the 87th minute when after a foul won by the Arcadians in a very good spot, Eder was stuffed and Alvarez took the header that went just over the opponent's goal.






