



## Death of Vasilis Kalogirou

The prosecutor of Larissa and mother of Kalogiros implies murder, speaks of a "boss": You who threw him into the mountains with the wild animals, what end will you have? Asks...

We note that the mother of the 39-year-old, Vasilis Kalogirou, acknowledged that the clothes of the body found in Pinios belong to her missing son.

It is recalled that the 39-year-old son of the Public Prosecutor of Appeals of Larissa was missing since December 30, 2024, with authorities conducting investigations to locate him.

The body was found after a citizen's call about the existence of a body on a hill, in the wider area of Pinios. According to information, a citizen called 100 and reported seeing the body of a man in the area of Perachora, Tyrnavos.

A short time later, strong police forces, firefighters and a forensic pathologist rushed to the scene.

### The possibility of homicide is not excluded

Coroner Dimitris Galenteris stressed from the outset that homicide could not be ruled out yet. "The case is of huge interest."

Still, he said that the rotting of the body and the wildlife of the Tyrnavos area "will certainly have distorted many of the findings," he said.

He added: "The autopsy will prove whether the body was transported there or ended up there. It is too early to rule out the possibility of homicide. The findings that will emerge, I think, will be minimal."

His mother, in addition to clothes and shoes, also recognized the keys found in the dead man's clothes. Questions remain, however, as DNA testing remains to lead to the identification or not of the body, while questions arise regarding the circumstances of the 39-year-old man's death.

## Earthquakes in Santorini and Amorgos: New warning Tselenti - "Be careful, we have a way to go" New earthquake of 4.9 on the Richter scale shortly after the strong earthquake of 5 on the Richter scale

Despite the recent statements of several scientists, namely that in recent days there has been a decline [in seismic](#) activity in the area between Santorini and Amorgos, two strong – among others – tremors were recorded in it in the last twenty-four hours.

On Monday morning, after days of relative "calm" without earthquakes exceeding 4 on the Richter scale, a 5.1 Richter earthquake occurred in Santorini. Indeed, the earthquake was also felt in Attica, while the same happened earlier on Tuesday morning, [when a new strong earthquake of 5 on the Richter scale was recorded shortly before 7:00 in the morning.](#)

This was followed by another earthquake of 4.9 on the Richter scale, according to data from the Institute of Geodynamics.

It is recalled that Akis Tselentis has from the beginning dissociated himself from the rest of the scientists who consider that the situation in the Cyclades is de-escalating. "Do you see any recession? I don't see," he continues in his post.

### Earthquakes in Santorini and Amorgos: "Likely to continue until summer," says Papazachos

There is a high probability that the earthquakes in Santorini and Amorgos will continue for another two to three months, explains Kostas Papazachos.

Seismology professor Kostas Papazachos, [speaking earlier on Monday morning about the very strong earthquake of 5.1 on the Richter](#) scale, which occurred around 9:49 in Santorini, said that this situation may continue until the summer. "It's a reality we can't overcome," he said.

At the same time, the well-known seismologist pointed out that "these sequences have micro-recessions and exacerbations, which compose a more difficult puzzle. So people should not forget and think that history is over. This story is not over and will still last. We will have more such earthquakes and sequences in the coming days."

The tremors continue in Santorini & Amorgos.  
The concern of residents and scientists is growing.

"In general, the picture that exists globally from such events, in which there is also a participation of magmatic stimulation, is that generally there are not very large earthquakes, just the area that has broken is quite large, around 30 kilometers and 30 kilometers is a large area. There are also neighboring faults. The possibility of a stronger earthquake in the same area cannot be excluded. It happens in some cases. That is why the measures remained strict, even though we saw the 2.5 days of silence, because we knew and we know that the situation there has not ended. Otherwise nobody wants to close schools, nobody wants to shut down areas. But people's safety comes first," he continued.

Regarding the movement of magma, he explained that magma is molten material that rises and exists in the earth and is stored in various areas

. "In some cases it will find a way to the surface. Where it comes out, a volcano will be created and that material that comes out is lava. So the material before it comes out we call it magma. And when it comes out, we call it lava. In some places magma pierces the surface, comes out and creates volcanoes. There are very specific points, Santorini, Nisyros, Milos, etc., but there are other places where there is," he added.

"One of these places was in Andros and they had seen it and seismic MRIs. That thing was there. This woke up, shakes and pushes over and wants to get out. Pressing breaks the rocks. The rocks anyway receive forces from tectonic faults and it becomes a mixed phenomenon.

The force that creates the faults and the material that presses underneath create these earthquakes. That doesn't mean magma will be able to drill into a volcano and all these stories.

Tempi: Agonizing efforts to  
change agenda ahead of protests –  
Mitsotakis "deposed"

The Mitsotakis government has its back against the wall, while revelations about the crime in Tempi and the attempts to cover it up come to light, which intensify the feeling of anger in society. The Prime Minister's team is looking for ways to change the agenda ahead of February 28, as it is estimated that the accumulated anger of society about what is happening will be expressed in a resounding way. It is obvious that citizens no longer trust the handling of Kyriakos Mitsotakis, who has been forced into multiple "cubisms" in order to protect himself at a communication level.

The prime minister's change of tack came in the wake of mass protests against the cover-up in late January. Specifically, in his interview with the main bulletin of Alpha, Kyriakos Mitsotakis, in order to diffuse the responsibilities to others and get himself out of the frame of responsibilities, said that it is possible that there was an illegal shipment, while for the debris he spoke of "operational initiatives", that no matter what happened, there was "no bad intention". He also said of the Tempe Select Committee that it was "not the best time" of the House.

In his last interview, in the newspaper "Kathimerini", he made sure to use again the rhetoric about... "instrumentalization" by opposition parties but also for the risk of... We become a "jungle". Cultivation of "institutional panic"

In short, the Mitsotakis team "sees" that the prime minister is now exposed and therefore they are looking for a way to "lock" the change of agenda aimed at disorienting public opinion from the crime of Tempi.

Beyond the line of "institutional panic" cultivated by the government, discussions about major geopolitical upheavals due to the new Trump doctrine are expected to multiply in the coming days. The government, with the narrative of stability, will try to set "borderline" dipoles, such as "Mitsotakis or chaos", which may be reflected in Greek-Turkish relations.

However, several members within the blue party believe that attempts to put the prime minister opposite society will not lead to a positive result. Many believe that the "dismantling" of the image of Mitsotakis is taking place, while discussions are "flaring up" even about a change "at sea" in Maximos...

Trump openly challenges Zelensky and calls for election - 'Sees' immediate meeting with Putin

**Donald Trump** has openly questioned Volodymyr Zelensky's legitimacy, saying there should be elections in Ukraine and saying he is highly likely to meet Vladimir Putin by the end of the month. The US president said the demand for presidential elections in Ukraine before any peace deal was reached "came from me".

His statement came after it was revealed that the US and Russia at a meeting in Riyadh on Tuesday (18/2) agreed that elections should be held before any peace process takes place. But the demand for elections is a long-standing demand of Russia, which has been voiced by Vladimir Putin and other senior officials, and Trump's mention is a victory for Moscow.

"**Yes, I would say that, you know, when you want a seat at the table...**" The people of Ukraine shouldn't have said something like, '**It's been a long time since we had an election,**'" Trump said.

"**We have a situation where there has been no election in Ukraine, where there is martial law in Ukraine, where the leader of Ukraine — I don't like to say it, but he has only 4 percent approval — and the country has disintegrated,**" Trump said.

The US president also claimed that Ukrainians, who are fighting for the survival of their country, are "tired" of death and destruction and want to see the war end.

"**People want to see something happen,**" he added. Elections have been a constant Russian demand. One of the last Russian officials to mention the need to hold elections in Ukraine was Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov. After first expressing Vladimir [Putin](#)'s readiness to talk to Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky if necessary, he then added that the legal basis of the agreements needed discussion, taking into account in view of the reality that Zelensky's legitimacy may be questioned. Ukraine is worried that Russia will use the ballot box to oust Volodymyr Zelensky during the war and install a pro-Russian candidate who will agree to peace terms favorable to Moscow.

The Ukrainian president was elected in 2019 for a five-year term, which normally expired in May 2024. Ukrainian officials say Russia's invasion of the country and Kiev's imposition of martial law prevent ballot boxes to be set up for a new president at this time. This is also provided for by Ukraine's constitution, which prohibits presidential, parliamentary or even local elections when martial law has been imposed in the country. Russia, however, insists that Zelensky's popular mandate has now expired. Ukrainian politics disagree and rarely hear "voices calling for presidential elections. Even Zelensky's political opponents acknowledge that it would be particularly difficult to organize presidential elections and ensure that there is no Russian involvement in them.

'**Ukraine started the war**' The US president's criticism continued with Trump saying he was "disappointed" by Kiev's reaction to his absence from the meeting in Riyadh, while appearing to blame Ukraine for starting the war, saying the country "could have made a deal".

Earlier, Volodymyr Zelensky said he was "surprised" that his country had not been invited to talks in Saudi Arabia to end the war with Russia. "I hear they're upset because they don't have a position, well, they had a position for three years and a long time before that. This could have been settled very easily," he said. "You should never have started it. You could have made a deal," he later added. "I could have made a deal for Ukraine," he said. "This would have given them almost all the land, everything, almost all the land – and no man would have been killed and no city demolished," he added.

After the meeting in Riyadh, Trump said he was "much more confident." Positive about sending troops to Ukraine Speaking about the prospect of sending European troops into Ukraine, Trump said: "If they want to do that, that's great, I'm in favor. If they want to do that, I think it would be fine. I mean, I know France has mentioned it, others have mentioned it, the UK has mentioned it." However, he added: "We won't have to put anybody over there because, you know, we're so far away." Lavrov made clear that his country would not accept peacekeepers from NATO countries in Ukraine as part of any peace deal, a proposal put forward at a meeting of European NATO members in Paris on Monday. For his part, Volodymyr Zelensky looked visibly tired and upset when he gave his reaction to Rojad's meeting during a news conference in Turkey. "We want everything to be fair and for no one to decide anything behind our backs," he said. "You can't make decisions without Ukraine on how to end the war in Ukraine," he added.

What was agreed in Riyadh?

Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov met with US Secretary of State Marco Rubio in Riyadh for the first high-level, face-to-face talks between the two countries since the start of the war in Ukraine.

The two ministers agreed to appoint teams to begin negotiating an end to the war.

According to Rubio, Moscow and Washington agreed on four principles at the Riyadh summit

The four principles agreed by the Americans and Russians are as follows.

- "Restoring the functionality of our respective missions in Washington and Moscow. In order to be able to continue moving along this path, we need to have diplomatic facilities that are functioning and functioning normally."
- "We will appoint a high-level group on our side to help negotiate and end the conflict in Ukraine in a way that is lasting and acceptable to all parties involved."
- "To start discussing and thinking and looking at both the geopolitical and economic cooperation that could result from ending the conflict in Ukraine."
- "The five of us who were here today ... We will remain involved in this process to ensure it proceeds in a productive manner."

The five people Rubio referred to were himself, national security adviser Mike Walz, special envoy Steve Whitkov, as well as Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov and presidential adviser Yuri Ushakov.

"It has nothing to do with the true meaning of what Mr. Dendias said for the umpteenth time about his personal journey or his relationship with the Prime Minister," the statement said.

"Findings of this kind require, at the very least, elementary communication about the accuracy of what is written," he concludes.

**Turkey withdrew from NATO exercise, Greece crossed line**

Previously, Athens effectively threatened to cancel the exercise if exclusively Turkish views on the status and jurisdiction of search and rescue and airspace in the Aegean were accepted.

Turkey has revealed that it withdrew some of its forces from NATO's Steadfast Dart 2025 exercise, as Greece insisted on its long-standing positions and the Alliance did not change its stance on Ankara's demands, [Kathimerini](#) writes.

However, Turkish officials say that "Greece at every opportunity tries to impose its positions." It is recalled that, as Kathimerini revealed, Athens essentially threatened to cancel the exercise, if the exclusively Turkish views on the status and jurisdiction of search and rescue and airspace in the Aegean were accepted.

Turkey's Defense Ministry sources claimed yesterday that *"after it was established that in the exercise planning document there were issues that contradict our national rights and interests and which are not in line with international law, efforts were made at the highest level in NATO to resolve the issue with a professional approach and it was pointed out that the document is not in line with established NATO policies and practices."*

*Greece tries to impose its positions at every opportunity, even in NATO exercises held in Greece. Lately, they have tried to introduce into this exercise some issues in the exercise planning document."*

According to Ankara, work has begun on amending the exercise planning document in line with Turkey's sensitivities and approving it at NATO level, and negotiations on the document are ongoing, without mentioning the outcome of the consultations.

According to well-informed Kathimerini sources, the inability to reach a decision at the level of permanent representatives transferred the issue to NATO defense ministers.

Turkey's main objection is the way in which various terminologies are described in the area of responsibility of the Supreme Military Commander for Europe (SACEUR), most notably airspace.

As a matter of routine, Turkey wants a general reference to "NATO Airspace", while Athens has proposed as a golden mean the use of a term that would include the concept of national (NATO Nation's Airspace). It is worth noting that the American delegation is close to Greek views.

Greek Cup Men's Basketball



Panathinaikos returned to the streets of victory and won the 21st Greek Cup in its history, defeating Olympiacos with a score of 81-76 in the final held at the indoor "Dyo Aorakia" in Heraklion, a victory that came after a hard battle, twists and tension until the last moment, reaffirming the competitiveness and passion that characterize the matches between the two best and most in-form teams of Greek basketball.

The greens started the game strongly, controlling Olympiacos' attacks. However, Olympiacos fought back and in the second quarter managed to equalize, even taking a small lead at halftime. However, the turnaround did not scare Panathinaikos, who in the second half came back with a more organized defense and offensive variety. The keys to victory for the greens were the excellent performance of Panathinaikos captain Kostas Sloukas, who scored 17 points and was decisive in crucial moments, but also the contribution of Kendariq Nan, who also contributed 17 points as well as Mr. double-double Juanzo Hernangometh of 11 points and 17 rebounds. The list of the... Panathinaikos' double-digit lead was completed by Jerian Grant with 10 points.

From Olympiacos, which also lost the racket battle, in which it theoretically prevailed, Sasha Vezenkov stood out with 17 points, while 10 points and 10 rebounds were the harvest of Mustafa Fal. Evan Fournier added 11 and Niger Williams-Goss 10. The last quarter was a real battle of nerves, with both teams alternating the lead and giving no room for mistakes. Panathinaikos, however, with composure and experience, managed to keep the opportunity in the end, thanks to crucial shots and defensive interventions that closed the game in their favor.

This victory is not just a trophy for Panathinaikos, but a declaration of intent for the rest of the season. It confirms that the Greens remain competitive and determined to claim the two remaining titles, that of the Greek Championship as well as the [Euroleague](#).

For Olympiacos, defeat is a tough disappointment, but also a reminder that the path to victory is never easy.
